FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

Following his baptism, Jesus "returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness, where for forty days he was tempted by the devil". The story of Jesus' temptations in the desert affirms his full humanity. After his baptism, but before he began his ministry, he was tempted just as we are. But in the end, Jesus prevailed. The challenge for us, when tempted to sin, is to respond as Jesus did, not succumbing to temptations, but relying upon God's grace and allowing this grace to support and sustain us. 
