AUGUST 15 - SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE **BLESSED VIRGIN MARY, SPECIAL PATRON OF ACADIANS:** The

Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary celebrates her being assumed – taken up body and soul – into heaven at the end of her earthly life. In declaring the doctrine of the Assumption (1950), the Church proclaims and celebrates that in Mary there was no obstacle to deny her immediate passing through death and becoming the first after her Son to be raised body and soul to fullness of life with God.

August 16 - Memorial of Saint Stephen of Hungary: At age 10, Stephen (975-1038) was baptized, together with his father, and at age 22 he succeeded his father to the throne of Hungary. He united Hungary in both politics and religion, suppressed revolts led by pagan nobles, instituted religious reforms, organized dioceses, founded monasteries, showed concern for the poor, and was accessible to all. In 1031 his only son lost his life in a hunting accident. When Stephen died in 1038, he was buried beside his son. Stephen was canonized in 1083.

August 19 - Memorial of Saint John Eudes, Priest: John was ordained in 1625, becoming a member of the Oratorians. However, seeing the urgent need for clerical reform, he left the Oratorians in 1643 to found the Congregation of Jesus and Mary, dedicated to upgrading the religious and intellectual formation of the clergy. Their symbol was the union of the hearts of Jesus and Mary. John died in 1680, was beatified in 1908, and was canonized in 1925. In the decree of beatification, Pope Pius X declared John Eudes to be the father, doctor and apostle of the devotions to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

AUGUST 20 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT BERNARD, ABBOT, DOCTOR:

Bernard gave up a life of privilege to become a monk. He was one of many monks sent out to begin new foundations. In the Valley of Light ('Clairvaux'), he founded the monastery where he ruled as abbot for the rest of his life. His writings and sermons have had a profound and lasting influence on Catholic spirituality. His abbey became the motherhouse for dozens of Cistercian monasteries around the world. Bernard was canonized in 1174 and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1830.

TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's Gospel provides much food for thought. When Jesus, the Prince of Peace, tells us that He has come to bring division and not peace, He is telling us that there is a cost to genuine peace. Today we are being challenged to stand up for our faith convictions when necessary, even among family members, relatives and friends. As Christians, for example, we believe in the dignity of human life from the moment of conception to natural death. To speak of this moral value in public can be a cause of division. The first Christians were martyred because of their faith values. Even today, Christians are being put to death simply for professing the Christian faith. Though embracing the Gospel values of our Lord Jesus Christ may be difficult at times, we can trust in the power of the Holy Spirit to ignite the fire within us, enabling us to speak the Word of God with boldness and so live up to our convictions.
