**NOVEMBER 30***TH* – **FEAST OF ST. ANDREW, APOSTLE.** Andrew was a fisherman from Bethsaida in Galilee. A disciple of John the Baptist, Andrew was present at Jesus's baptism. When John stated, "Behold the Lamb of God", Andrew understood and followed Jesus. He declared to his brother, Simon Peter, that he had found the Messiah. Thus Andrew is known as the first disciple of Jesus. Later, he was among the twelve apostles chosen by Jesus. He is a patron saint of Scotland and Russia, of the Greek Church, and of the fishing industry.
