Synod on Synodality Mission

And now we get to the most exciting part of the Synod on Synodality! Yes, communion and participation are very important.

They are a necessity to determine the mission. If we really think about it, our Church (that's us!) exists to reach out to people, to evangelize. Our Church should never be centered on itself. Jesus always reached out to others; he was never self-centered. The mission of our Church is to witness to the love of God that is extended to the entire human family. This Synod on Synodality has a deeply missionary dimension. We are invited to come together in communion and to participate in an effort that will enable the Church to better carry out its mission. We are invited to participate in exploring how our Church is carrying out its mission, how it has strayed from its journey, and how changes can be made to bring it back to its mission to witness to the Gospel. We have been invited, through this synod to assist our Church to fulfill her mission more fruitfully of evangelization in the world at the service of the coming of God's kingdom.

HOLY WEEK: Holy Week is the week which precedes the great feast of the Resurrection of the Lord on Easter Sunday. The week begins with Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord, includes the last days of Lent, and ends on Holy Saturday with the beginning of the Easter Vigil. During Holy Week, the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his life on earth, beginning with his messianic entrance into Jerusalem and culminating with his Passion and Death on the Cross. Though Holy Week is solemn and sorrowful, it anticipates the Easter joy of Christ's resurrection which brings new life to all who believe.

PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

The beginning of today's Mass recalls the messianic entrance of the Lord Jesus into Jerusalem, coming to complete his Paschal Mystery. In the Passion Narrative we see the model for all love – the sacrificial love of Jesus which continues to be available for each of us. This love is made manifest as Jesus, the Suffering Servant, heals the injured slave in the Garden of Gethsamene, comforts the weeping women, forgives his executioners, and welcomes the repentant thief. Jesus' love culminates in his death on the cross for our salvation. Such great love ought to guide our personal and communal life as Christians and as Church.
