

AUGUST 21 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT PIUS X, POPE: Pius X, formerly Giuseppe Sarto, was born in Italy in 1835. At age 23 he was ordained a priest and was involved in pastoral ministry for 17 years. He became a bishop in 1884, a cardinal in 1892, and was elected pope in 1903. He died in 1914 and was canonized in 1954. His recommendations and encyclicals reflect his pastoral background: he advocated frequent communion for adults, sacramental preparation for children, and catechism instruction for everyone.

AUGUST 22 - MEMORIAL OF THE QUEENSHIP OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY: In 1954, Pope Pius XII instituted this memorial “so that all may clearly recognize and more zealously venerate the kind and maternal rule of the Mother of God” (*Ad Caeli Reginam*). This memorial is celebrated on the Octave of the Solemnity of the Assumption.

August 23 - Memorial of Saint Rose of Lima, Virgin: Rose was born in 1586 in Lima, Peru. While still young, she chose for herself a life of prayer and penance, subjecting her body to austerities as well as deprivation of food and sleep. As a result, she endured interior periods of darkness and desolation as well as mystical experiences. She joined the Third Order of St. Dominic and lived in a little hut in her parents’ garden, working to help support them. She died in 1617 at age 31, and in 1671 she became the first canonized saint of the New World.

Thanks to the generosity and support of many people in the diocese we have welcomed our third family who are seeking refugee status in Canada. The newest family is a family of four who will be living in Clarendville. The two girls are of school age and will be enrolling in the school here in Clarendville in September. The family is presently doing the things that most of us take for granted: opening bank accounts, arranging Internet service, finding an apartment and furnishings, in short, getting the things that will make their lives here more secure than the life they had to leave in Yemen. TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's Gospel provides much food for thought. When Jesus, the Prince of Peace, tells us that He has come to bring division and not peace. He is telling us that there is a cost to genuine peace. Today we are being challenged to stand up for our faith convictions when necessary, even among family members, relatives and friends. As Christians, for example, we believe in the dignity of human life from the moment of conception to natural death. To speak of this moral value in public can be a cause of division. The first Christians were martyred because of their faith values. Even today, Christians are being put to death simply for professing the Christian faith. Though embracing the Gospel values of our Lord Jesus Christ may be difficult at times, we can trust in the power of the Holy Spirit to ignite the fire within us, enabling us to speak the Word of God with boldness and so live up to our convictions.
