SPECIAL DAYS OF THE WEEK

July July 16 - Memorial of Our Lady of Mount Carmel: The Order of Carmel dates back to a group of Western hermits who in the 12th century settled on Mount Carmel, overlooking the plain of Galilee, in imitation of the prophet Elijah. They grouped themselves around a small chapel dedicated to Our Lady. In the 13th century, the Order of Carmel was formed, retaining the twin devotions of the early hermits: to Elijah and his solitary prayer, and to Our Lady under the title 'of Mount Carmel'.

<u>July 20 - Memorial of Saint Apollinaris, Bishop, Martyr</u>: One of the first bishops of the early Church, Apollinaris lived in the first century. During his life he was repeatedly exiled and tortured but continued to evangelize and work miracles until his martyrdom. He was one of the first great martyrs.

July 21 - Memorial of Saint Lawrence of Brindisi, Priest, Doctor: At the age of 16, Lawrence entered the Capuchin Franciscan Order in Verona, Italy. He died in 1619, was canonized in 1881, and named Doctor of the Church in 1959.
