**For clarification**, there is no advantage to being in a higher tax bracket.

**The Federal savings** is 15% on the first \$200 and 29% on any additional contributions.

**The Provincial savings** is 8.7% on the first \$200 and 18.3% on any additional contributions.

**Therefore**, if you make donations around \$200 in a year, it is better to save them until the following year, if you do not need the short term cash. That way, additional money will be at the higher rate - 47.3% (federal and provincial together).

### FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

*The key theme in today's readings is unworthiness in the face of the greatness of God. Isaiah proclaims that he is "a man of unclean lips"; Paul admits that he is 'unfit to be called an Apostle'; Peter confesses that he is 'a sinful man'. Yet God has a job for them all, and they respond to the call: they will speak on God's behalf to the people; they will "fish for people". We too are called by God. The fact that we are baptized means that we have a vocation, a call. That's just as certain as the call of our Scripture heroes today. What do we need to leave behind as we respond to that call?*

**Children's Sunday Liturgy:** The children's liturgy takes place each Sunday morning, during Mass. Appropriate ages are 4+ years.

**Family Mass:** A family Mass takes place in our parish, the last Sunday of each month. This is a special Mass for families and all families are encouraged to attend.

**EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT:** On the first Friday of each month, there will be an exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at the parish Chapel at 10:30 am. Mass to follow at 11:00 am.

**Holy Communion at Home:** If you or someone you know who would like to receive Holy Communion in their home, you are asked to please inform Father Patrick or phone the parish office @ 538-3106. The Body of Christ is often such an important part of people's lives, so when they are sick or unable to come to Mass, I would gladly bring them Holy Communion.

**February 11 - Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes:** The veneration of Mary as Our Lady of Lourdes arose first in popular devotion and later in the Church's liturgy. In 1858 Mary, the Mother of Jesus, appeared to Bernadette Soubirous in a cave at Massabielle, near Lourdes in France. Just four years earlier, in 1854, the Church had declared the dogma of the Immaculate Conception, so when the "beautiful woman" of Bernadette's vision identified herself as the Immaculate Conception, there was initial scepticism. However, an Episcopal Commission, following an official inquiry, stated: "We judge that Mary, the Immaculate Mother of God, did really appear to Bernadette Soubirous on February 11, 1858, and on certain subsequent days, 18 times in all, in the Grotto of Massabielle, near the town of Lourdes; that this appearance bears every mark of truth and that the belief of the faithful is well-grounded." A few years later, this date was added to the list of Marian feasts to honour the mystery and beauty of the Immaculate Conception.

**FEBRUARY 11 - WORLD DAY OF THE SICK:** This day, the Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes, is also "World Day of the Sick". On this day we are reminded that the ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church, and that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. The feast highlights the healing ministry of the Church and recognizes the great efforts of doctors, nurses, health care institutions, and pastoral care givers to restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease. The theme of Pope Francis' Message for this year's 27<sup>th</sup> World Day of the Sick is "***You received without payment; give without payment***" (Mt. 10.8).
