SEPTEMBER 16 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT CORNELIUS, POPE, AND SAINT CYPRIAN, BISHOP,

MARTYRS: Saints Cornelius and Cyprian were friends and allies. Cornelius was elected Pope during the Decian persecution (250-251). In 253, under renewed persecution, he was arrested and banished. He died in exile the same year. Cyprian of Carthage was a convert to Christianity and became a Priest shortly after his conversion. In 249, he became a Bishop. When the Decian persecution began, he went into hiding and supported his flock by letter. Later he was arrested, banished, and condemned to death, showing great faith and courage in the face of martyrdom.
